

Tip: If it cracks, add a little water to smooth it out.

Optional: Paint your seashells before adding them to the salt dough.

6. Poke a hole for hanging into each seashell pressed dough pendant by inserting a toothpick. Make sure the hole is not too close to the edge, so it won't break later and that it's big enough to fit a string through it.



7. Let dry. Place the seashell pendants on a plate and leave outside in the sun to dry for a full day.

Option: Place the seashell pendants on a baking tray and bake in the oven at 180°F turning every 10-15min. Be sure to “repoke” your hanging holes as the salt dough can spread and shut in the oven.

8. Once dry, thread a string through each seashell pendant and you are ready to wear your beautiful necklace!
